Program Description

In 1968, Walter Lee and Agnes H. Gladstone generously willed funds to West Presbyterian Church to assist students wishing to enter into active Christian work. Now administered by The United Presbyterian Church of Binghamton (UPC), the Gladstone Christian Scholarship Trust Committee solicits applications each year from students interested in being part of the program.

This program allows students to apply for grants of up to \$1,000 per person per academic year. If special circumstances exist, the Gladstone Christian Scholarship Trust Committee may recommend increasing this amount. The grant may be repaid at a later time if financial circumstances permit.
